### CURRENT STATUS / SITUATION ACTUELLE

In August, I attended the Canadian Association of police governance meeting in Calgary. There were many interesting presentations beginning on Friday, August 9. One presentation was entitled "Police governance at a crossroads" and dealt with the struggles of various commissions and boards related to their role of governance as the oversight body for police services. I learned that the actions of any board have a direct impact on their ability to carry out their legislative function of setting policy. There was an update and helpful recommendations which will be shared with the Governance Committee. Another presentation on August 10th, dealt with the creation of a police governance dashboard. A template was developed by the Canadian Association of Police Governance which is being made available to all CAPG boards and commission members. This will also be shared with the Governance Committee and will be part of our overview of the CRPA structure being conducted by an external consultant. There were many other presentations looking at strategic planning, addressing inequality, investing in mental health and public safety personnel along with various police models available throughout the country. The networking at this conference was extremely helpful and allows for the establishment of various contacts throughout the country.
