CURRENT STATUS / SITUATION ACTUELLE

The Quality of Policing Committee met on August 22, 2019.

- Under the Provincial Police Act a Portion of ticket fines collected in each municipality (POPA Tickets) are to be remitted to that municipality as per agreements. There is currently no revenue received from the Province of New Brunswick. A letter of enquiry will be sent to the Province.
- Possibility to use speed / red light cameras in greater Moncton - - Motor vehicle Act violations can only be done by the police at present. Legislative changes are required to enable charging the owner of the vehicle, not the operator. A letter from the CRPA to Province with a copy to municipalities will be sent regarding the required changes to legislation.
- Upcoming presentations to the CRPA
 - Community Policing – Christy Elliott and Patrick Pilon have presented this evening.
 - Policing Services for NB will present to the CRPA in November on the Police Act, the board's role within the judicial system, etc.
 - The Director of the Criminal Intelligence Service New Brunswick (CISNB) will speak to the CRPA in November on intelligence based services and procedures.
- A Household Emergency Information Guide distributed to the community by the Fredericton Police Force was reviewed. This will be assessed for possible implementation here.
- Community safety initiatives in other jurisdictions that were part of the Canadian Association of Police Governance (CAPG) conference were reviewed. Of particular note was the Lightwatch crime/theft app based program in Grand Prairie that enables citizens to report crimes/suspicious activities in real time. This will be researched for applicability here.
- The CRPA's Strategic Planning process is continuing. The second phase begins in the fall.
