As a committee of the CRPA, the Governance Committee is responsible for all matters concerning the governance. The responsibilities include the following:

- Determining and recommending all changes to the Policy and Procedures Manual of the CRPA;
- 2. Considering and recommending all proposed changes to the structure of format of the CRPA;
- 3. Annually evaluating the work of the CRPA against its strategic plan.

In compliance with its responsibilities, the Governance Committee continually review its by-laws and Policy and Procedures Manual to ensure it is in conformity with the object of the CRPA and its strategic plan. A recent review of our Policy Manual and By-Laws revealed a significant number of outdated references and wording in both our Policy manual and By-Laws as a result of policy changes and also legislative changes. The Governance Committee therefore recommended to the Board the adoption of an amended Policy Manual and By-Law and these were adopted on May 9, 2019.

Also, as Chair of the Governance Committee, I attended together with the chair of the CRPA Board, the CAPG 29th Annual Conference. The conference theme was Police Governance Reform: The Age of Enlightenment. The conference was held in Winnipeg and ran from August 9 to August 11, 2018. The networking opportunities were incredibly valuable. That said, over and above the personal connections, the most pertinent value was to gain a better understanding of how other boards function, and ideas as to how best they improve the functionality of the Codiac Regional Policing Authority.
