CURRENT STATUS / SITUATION ACTUELLE

While this past year was met with many challenges because of the pandemic, the Codiac Regional Policing Authority (CRPA) successfully maintained its focus on its mandate. It is responsible to the municipalities of Moncton, Dieppe and Riverview for the purpose of providing regional policing services to the municipalities and to ensure adequacy of strategic planning, police coverage, and fiscal management of the Regional Police Service. It has not lost sight of any of these responsibilities. One of the CRPA commitments is to be open, transparent, accountable, and accessible to the community. During this past fiscal year, a dedicated effort has been made to these commitments. We have seen further improvements of the KPI's (Key Performance Indicators) and the dashboard, which is accessible on-line and provides additional transparency, accountability, and accessibility. I wish to recognize the board members for continuing to fulfill the mandate of the Board with dedication on behalf of the citizens of the three municipalities.
