### ANNUAL REPORT / RAPPORT ANNUEL

The Quality of Policing Committee (QPC) continued to oversee the reporting to the CRPA. Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) have been reported as part of the Officer in Charge report throughout the year. Use of the CRPA website continues to increase. The website provides information to all stakeholders, thereby enhancing accountability and transparency.

**CRPA Dashboard update:** The dashboard has area specific data and is multi-purpose for all municipalities. Data reflects on 21 key performance indicators which the RCMP and CRPA are focused on and provides summary data on the types of crimes being committed. Key performance indicators and the recommendations for policing priorities for the Codiac region will be reviewed at an upcoming meeting of the members of the CRPA, the RCMP leadership team, and the mayors from all three municipalities.

**Annual Performance Plan:** The APP consists of performance targets set in 12 key areas that the RCMP are focused on. There was considerable improvement in each area over the course of the year where 10 of the 12 targets were reached. This is remarkable progress thus far and should reflect overall improvement in service for our region.

#### **Media and public relations role within Codiac RCMP:**

Approval was granted for the hiring of a new Communications Officer for the Codiac RCMP. This person would be responsible for improving communications to the public and act as the voice of the RCMP via the media. The hiring process has begun and is ongoing.

#### **Community Policing Center:**

The new Community Policing Center will be located at 795 Main St. with renovations expected to be completed shortly with the opening date likely to be late summer 2022.
